Lawyer Referral Service Available to Members

Members of the Bar Association of Frederick County can join the Baltimore County Bar Association's (BCBA) ABAcertified Lawyer Referral Service (LRS). The BCBA <u>will waive</u> the \$175 annual fee for BAFC members. In addition, the BCBA LRS will waive the requirement for BAFC panel attorneys to perform four, two-hour mandatory screening sessions per program year. Any calls received from Frederick County residents will be referred to Frederick County LRS panel attorneys.

The referral year runs from July 1 - June 30. You can sign up at any point online or through a physical copy during the year and will need to reapply for every year that you would like to remain on Lawyer Referral.

Online and paper application available <u>HERE</u>. After reading over the LRIS Rules and completing the application in it's entirety, please download the application. Once the application is downloaded, please email the application and a Declaration Sheet from your legal malpractice carrier to <u>abah@bcba.org</u>. Following your application submission, you will receive an invoice via email. After the invoice is paid to the BCBA, you will be active and able to receive referrals. If you would like to turn in a physical application please follow the mailing directions on the application.
